

Q31. Would you like to see the redevelopment of Iver High Street, and if so what sort of facilities, services and features would you support? Please comment freely on how you would like to see this area redeveloped.

This is just a trial summary of the responses which were submitted online (and does not include the postal responses). It is NOT a systematic analysis of all the responses, and is solely for the purpose of initiating a discussion on the possible format of an analysis to this question (NB different questions may benefit from different formats).

The dominant response was firstly to resolve the traffic and parking issues, and secondly to refurbish the currently vacant shops (including the old Midland Bank, The Chequers and The Bull).

Other comments included:

- Relocation of the workshops at 11-19 High Street
- More independent shops
- Smarten up existing shops in character with the older properties
- No more takeaways or estate agents
- Shops selling local products
- Restaurants/bars
- Lower shop rents
- Pedestrian-only High Street
- A bank
- Facilities for cyclists including cycle lanes and cycle racks
- It looks run down and dirty
- Bus shelters
- Proper village square with open space and seating
