Aims:

1. To provide a safe and relaxed environment for all members of our school community to receive the support they need.
2. To provide a community service to help ensure the local community is more resilient
3. To help develop a strong sense of community
4. To improve children's attainment and aspirations by engaging their parents more in school, by making it easier and more attractive for them to visit school through co-location of other services

How we are going to do this:

1. Appoint a member of staff with responsibility for making links with the community and outside agencies. This member of staff will actively engage with the local community to develop proposals for further use of the school site
2. Connect with outside agencies. In particular, the focus will be on housing, parenting and education
3. Meetings with families and social care to be held in this room. This includes social worker visits to children and contact sessions for children in care when appropriate.
4. Work with local schools to share training and good practice

How will the project or activities benefit the residents of The Ivers?

We have seen members of our community struggle and need help – we want to make sure we are here for everyone, providing the right support where needed through 1:1 sessions and newsletters. We want to be able to provide trained mental health workers to support families in a relaxed environment so that the children are in a better position to learn. We believe that unless children feel safe and secure they will not be able to meet their potential.

We hope that people in the local community will have further access to the services they need

As part of this project we would also like to offer courses for the local community on healthy eating, literacy skills etc.
