

## Streetlight Replacement Programme

### 1.0 Background



The Streetlight Replacement Programme changes existing lighting stock with low usage LED lights (Pilzeo 16L 500Ma Lanterns) that are more economic to run and operate and give improved lighting. So far, **355** of our lighting stock of 565 (62%) has been replaced with LED Urbis Pilzeo fittings. The lighting stock is changed by our existing lighting contractor – SSE Contracting.

### 2.0 Budget and Inventory

The Budget for Streetlight Replacement Programme in 2021/22 is **£40,128**. There is also **£5,000** in 2021/22 for Highways Projects.

At current prices excluding VAT, the budget will allow for **83** new lamps to be supplied and fully installed at £39,983. Considering the use of the Highways Projects budget would allow **93** lamps to be replaced costing £44,725 excluding VAT.

- *Completing a further 83 in 2021/22 would result in 438 completed – 78%*
- *Completing a further 93 in 2021/22 would result in 448 completed – 80%*

### 3.0 Inventory of lighting stock

Appendix 8b lists the stock that has previously been replaced with Pilzeo LED lighting. Appendix 8c lists those with the potential to be changed as the programme continues.

### 4.0 Decisions

- a) To agree the number of lamps required and action the Deputy Clerk to place an order via SSE to secure the stock at the current quoted price and commission the work via SSE Contracting
- b) To agree on the locations for the next phase of replacement.
