## CHARITY COMMISSION.

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In the Matter of the Charity called or known as IVER HEATH RECREATION GROUND, in the Parish of IVER, in the County of BUCKINGHAM, comprised in the following Instruments :—

Conveyance dated 22nd December 1930 ;

Conveyance dated 12th May 1931 ; and

In the Matter of “ The Charitable Trusts Acts, 1853 to 1939.”

**The Board of Charity Commissioners for England and Wales,** upon an application made to them on the 14th February 1939, under the Common Seal of the body Corporate called

THE NATIONAL PLAYING FIELDS ASSOCIATION ;

the Trustees of the above-mentioned Charity :

**And** after due notice of the intention to make this Order published according to the direction of the Board by being affixed to or near a principal outer door of the Parish Church of Iver Heath and the Post Office, Slough Road, Iver Heath, on the 8th June 1939 (being more than one calendar month before the date hereof) :

**And** having received no notice of any objection to the proposed Order or suggestion for the variation thereof :

**And** after due communication of the draft of the subjoined Scheme to the Parish Council of Iver :

**Do hereby Order** as follows :—

The subjoined Scheme is approved and established.

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### SCHEME.

The Trustees of the above-mentioned Charity may let to the Parish Council of Iver the land specified in the Schedule hereto and forming the endowment of the Charity, for a term of 99 years at an annual rent of one shilling, provided that the lease of the said land to the Council shall contain a covenant that the said Council will, during the term of the said lease, use the said land as a public open space and for no other purpose.

## SCHEDULE.

A piece of land of irregular shape situate to the south-east side of Church Road, Iver Heath, in the Parish of Iver, and measuring on the north-west side 708 feet or thereabouts, on the north-east side 443 feet or thereabouts, on the south-east side 702 feet or thereabouts and on the south-west side 337 feet or thereabouts, together with a strip of land measuring in width 13 feet 6 inches or thereabouts, leading from the said piece of land to Church Road aforesaid and having a frontage thereto of 15 feet or thereabouts, which said piece of land and strip of land contain in the aggregate 6 acres 3 roods 20 poles or thereabouts.

A strip of land situate in the said Parish, contiguous to the above-mentioned piece of land, having a frontage of 8 feet or thereabouts to the south-west side of Bangors Road and a mean depth therefrom of 200 feet or thereabouts, being the land comprised in a Conveyance dated 12th May 1931 made between Arthur Sherren of the first part, Alice LePeer Trevor Williams of the second part, The National Playing Fields Association of the third part and Lewis Brown and three others of the fourth part.
