Subject: Bare Roots

Hi Jem, today Nicole and Julie and I had a look at the hedge that needs to be planted to fulfil the planning application at the new Jubilee pavilion, had a quick measure and it seems to be 51metres, minus a gate for the tractor to get through, so at 60cm apart we need roughly 80 plants,(about £1.50 per plant) this could be brought now as small bare root plants and potted and stored on one of the allotments until the autumn and then put in place at the pavilion, would also need to get some stock proof fencing and 7 posts to support the stock proofing, cost of fencing about £200 plus labour, which should take no longer than 1 day two people.

Hope this sound like a viable idea
