Briefly describe the project / purpose for which you require a grant.

- CA Bucks will deliver outreach Citizens Advice services for one full day once a month based out of the Iver Parish Council office.
- The service will be delivered by a highly experienced adviser using IT and telephony equipment supplied by CA Bucks. We will also provide remote supervision support to the Adviser as required during the days of operation at the outreach location.
- We expect to make up to 6 “appointment slots” available for a full day’s service
- CA Bucks can set up referral pathways for some specific partner organisations (TBD); we can also create a *Referral Form* to be sent into our outreach inbox to facilitate this process.
- CA Bucks will also utilise the appointments slots to serve local clients who need a face-to-face appointment because they are particularly vulnerable. This is in addition to the information and advice that all local clients will be able to access on our website, via our self-referral form, or using our Adviceline.

How will the project or activities benefit the residents of The Ivers?

- Citizens Advice provides free, confidential, independent and expert advice that *empowers* people facing challenges in their lives to *help* themselves; we provide direct support to those that can’t.
- Our top advice areas are Debt; Benefits; Housing & Employment. We know that clients often present with a complex combination of these and other issues when they need help from us. Many of our clients benefit from improved financial outcomes (for example in the form of benefits) and also we know that successful resolution of their problems is a significant contributor to improvements in the Mental Health conditions of our clients.
- We would expect to provide a direct benefit to an additional 60 clients by operating this outreach service; this would equate an average of 5 clients per advice session per once a month for the full year.
- Based on our own data analyses we estimate that this service could provide indirect benefit to upto 240 Iver residents (we typically use a x4 multiple in these estimates).
