Iver Heath Bowls Club is applying for a grant from Veolia Environmental Trust Community Fund.

We are applying for a new 8m x 3m prefabricated building that will replace the perished container that was put on the site temporarily when we had our fire in the 1990s. The new building will be accessible and environmentally friendly and be multi-purpose.

1. Community use when our club house is in use. Several organisations already use our facilities, some free of charge, including Carers Bucks, the Community Choir and the Residents Association.
2. A Club meeting room
3. Additional changing room for visitors and/or juniors.
4. Spectator viewing in inclement weather for vulnerable people.
5. A social area for juniors away from the bar.

We also plan to landscape the area that the Parish Council donated to us adjacent to the recreation ground. We have already spent £18K installing a new fence and removing the old hedge.

We will make it more accessible for wheelchair users and improve the look of the recreation ground. We will increase biodiversity by planting 20% of the area with wild flowers, install insect boxes and use reclaimed material wherever possible.

I have attached details of the 10% funding.

We expect that the total cost of this project will be no more **£38,500** and may be less. Subsequently we are asking for up to **£3,850** from IPC to secure a grant from Veolia of **£34,650**

It is of course no means certain that we will secure this grant.

The grant decision date is September 6th so we would expect your 10% contribution to be paid in October/November 2022.

The grant application must be submitted by July 7th so we would be grateful if this could be discussed at your June meeting.

We would welcome a visit from any Parish Councillors if you would like to discuss the project in more detail.
