

ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING POINTS

1. Background

Cllr Kinchin brought to the attention of the Open Spaces and Highways committee on 24th November 2022 of a Government Scheme regarding Electric Charging Points. The following minute was taken:

347/21 ELECTRIC CHARGING POINTS

Following discussion, it was felt that this should be explored further and Peter Kinchin brought to the committee's attention a Government Scheme that funded 100% of installation (70% upfront & 30% on completion). Cllr Peter Kinchin agreed to forward the information to the Deputy Clerk for review and the matter to be brought back to a future meeting.

2. Current status

Cllr Kinchin and the Deputy Clerk with support from a representative from BP put in a detailed application in March 2022 for two Electric Charging Points at Iver Recreation Ground at the point of application, the funding opportunity was 70% upfront and 30% on completion.

We heard following this application that we had applied too late for the 2021/22 funding application period and that the funding opportunity for the 2022/23 application period is now only 60% and 40% on completion.

Based on this, a slightly different form was supplied and this has been completed and is now being considered.

Oral updates will be given at the meeting.
