

Deputy Clerk's Update

Fencing – Iver Allotments

Several areas of fencing on the perimeter with the Recreation Ground need repair / replacement – Quote being sought for completion. This includes the closing off of the 'gap' access from Grange Way. Evidence exists if it being part of a cut through to the Recreation Ground. (The main entrance to the Allotment is now padlocked). As part of this an inspection has been done of old damaged wire fencing that will be removed by the Grounds Team for safety purposes.

Parish Hanging Baskets

Installed at the beginning of July across the entire Parish. The service contract includes regular watering that is being undertaken early mornings.

Iver Heath Allotment Car Park area

Once the ground isn't so hard it will be evened out by Albert Huber late Summer or after a period of rain.

OPM – Oak Processionary Moths

Clearance of trees identified by Bartlett Tree Services. Trees registered with the Forestry Commission to be part of the free spraying programme in early 2023 should it proceed. Letters confirming this are on file.

Streetlights Maintenance

No issues and only two outstanding defects for repair. Updates on contract tendering and replacement programme reported elsewhere.

Cycle Racks

There is one set of cycle racks outstanding to be installed at Iver Heath Recreation Ground. This is being progressed.

Japanese Knotweed

The implemented 10-year plan continues. Last site visits to both sites were June 2022.

Height Barrier Maintenance

Maintenance completed at both height barriers. New signage at Iver Recreation Ground as height limit is less.

Iver Heath Fenced Play Area gate / fence

The gate / fence to the play area was buckled giving rise to a health and safety issue. Remedial work was completed early June 2022. (this was previously identified and was also highlighted on the RoSPA May 2022 report for the play area.
