

RoSPA Inspection – May 2022

The annual inspection of our Play Areas and Recreation Grounds took place un-announced on 5th May 2022.

The following reports were received at the end of May:

In summary, there were 41 reports across the 5 sites that required attention:

Our usual checks / inspections had previously identified 8 of the actions required (These are designated by 'Previously identified' in the Action to Take column.)

The 2 remaining High priorities are both Cycle Mounds. The Committee should make decisions in what to do with these at the next Committee Meeting in September so the Deputy Clerk can be actioned to progress.
