

## STREETLIGHT REPLACEMENT PROGRAMME

Appendix 9a

The Parish Council is entering the third year of the streetlight light replacement programme with the objective of ensuring the entire lighting network maintained by the Council is energy efficient and therefore reduces the cost of the un-metered supply of energy to the network. This is in line with the climate emergency declared by the Council in previous years.

The budget for Highways Lighting Projects for 2022/23 is £40,000.

In order to complete the programme, the following 4 schemes are proposed in conjunction with our current streetlight contractor:

### Replace 7 Ornate Lanterns with Windsor LED Lantern at

- Bathurst Walk, Richings Park (7) – see over

**Cost: £7,794 ex VAT**

### Replace 8 lamps with Urbis Axia Gen 3 LED Lanterns

- Mansion Lane (6)
- Norwood Lane (2)

**Cost: £2,567 ex VAT**

### Replace 11 lamps with Pilzeo 16 LED Lanterns

- Bond Close (2)
- Heatherden Green (3)
- Keens Acre (2)
- Mansion Lane (2)
- Widcroft Road (2)

**Cost: £7,866 ex VAT**

### Iver Heath Recreation Ground Lighting Overhaul

- 18 LED Floodlights (10 Rec Car Park, 8 Basketball Court)

**Cost: £4,045 ex VAT**

**TOTAL COST: £22,272 ex VAT**

*These costs are inclusive of all installation costs including labour.*

On completion of this phase, our entire streetlighting network across the Parish will be the most cost efficient possible and working with the SSEN Un-Metered Supply Team we will ensure our electricity costs reflect the inventory we have.

## **Recommendations:**

- That the elements of the third phase of the replacement programme highlighted above with the costs be agreed by the Committee and the Deputy Clerk is actioned to progress with this activity in conjunction with our streetlight contractor for installation as soon as possible.
- The Deputy Clerk is actioned to progress with the liaising with our lighting contractor to develop a scheme of work to provide lighting at Swan Road, Iver and bring this to the January 2023 Meeting for consideration of inclusion in this phase of the streetlight replacement programme. (The estimated remainder of the budget after this phase is £17,728). Alternatively, it can be part of the Highways Lighting Projects for next year.
- The Deputy clerk is also actioned to liaise with SSEN to ensure our UMS certificate reflections the new inventory once this phase of work is completed.
