Briefly describe the project / purpose for which you require a grant.

As part of the initiative across the Ivers, in conjunction with the Parish Council and other local voluntary organisations we intend to provide a “warm space” throughout the winter months each Monday from 11am to 2pm in the Annexe at St Peter’s Church starting on 9<sup>th</sup> January 2023. We will provide free tea and coffee from 11am onwards and a free light (hot) meal from 12.30pm to 2pm, probably soup and a roll or something similar. We also aim to provide newspapers, magazines, and variety of games for those who wish to use them.

How will the project or activities benefit the residents of The Ivers?  
Please include estimates of the number of Iver residents that will receive a direct benefit from the project or activities.

This is intended to provide a safe and warm space for those struggling with the current cost of living crisis and will be open to anyone from within the Ivers and surrounding areas. Until we start it is difficult to estimate the numbers attending. Initially we will have capacity for approximately 20-25 in the Annexe at St Peter’s church, but if demand exceeds this, we could potentially relocate to the St Peter’s Centre next door which could accommodate larger numbers.

Please provide a breakdown of the costs of your project.

Cost of Energy        £10.00 per week  
(This is an estimate, but we will take meter readings for gas and electricity after the first week to gauge actual amount of energy used and then advise you accordingly)

Cost of Food and drink PER WEEK (based on 20-25 people attending)

Soup                    £12.50  
Baguettes            £ 5.25  
Coffee                 £ 9.00 (based on 2 cups per person)  
Tea                     £ 2.00 (Based on 2 cups per person)  
Biscuits               £ 2.40 (36 biscuits)

**Total (incl Heating)** £41.15 per week x 12 weeks (until end of March) = £493.80

Obviously, if we do not have 20-25 people each week then the food can be used (whilst still “in date”) in following week (except the baguettes). At the end of March 2023, we will provide receipts for all food expenditure and then refund to Ivers Parish Council anything of the £500 which is unspent.
