We would like to organise a community celebration similar to the one organised by the IVRA for the Platinum Jubilee last year. We intend for the event to highlight many aspects of helping and volunteering in the community in accordance with the designation of the day as the Big Help Out.

The residents will be encouraged to volunteer their time before, during, and after the event. We also aim to design the activities in a way that includes messages about caring for others, the environment, and animals.

As this is work in progress, the costs provided are an estimate and we will aim to return unused grant funds if we don't use the whole sum.


If membership of your organisation is restricted, please provide details.
