We are a Charity Organisation called AK Foundation which was registered in 2011. The registration number is 1143251.

I decided to set up the charity on behalf of my son Aakash Khera. He was brain damaged at birth and has Cerebral Palsy, he is now 29 years old. During the early years of his life he received excellent treatment from Great Ormond St Hospital and therefore we have raised money on many occasions to support the hospital and continue to send them monthly contributions .

Over the past few years I have found that homelessness is such a big factor in today's society. I therefore started feeding homeless people and started providing them with clothes, shoes and sleeping bags.

A K Foundation has also helped school children from low income families by providing food parcels to the schools during the holidays, We provided Lilliput nursery and junior school in Iver with food parcels at Christmas for 23 families and would like to continue providing support during this year.

I would like to request permission from you to place a clothing bank at the car park in Recreation Car Park in Iver to collect charity clothes and shoe donations. The banks will be emptied on a regular basis and taken to be sorted at our charity storage. The driver will always ensure that the area around the banks are kept clean and tidy at all times.

We can offer you £360 per year per clothing bank, simply to say thank you .
